ALCOHOL/SMOKE/SUBSTANCE FREE LIVING ENVIRONMENT POLICY

We now know from empirical data that every day in the United States, more than 3,000 young people become smokers. That's more than one million new smokers a year! More than half of all smokers begin smoking before the age of 14, and 90% begin by the age of 19. In conjunction with the University's initiatives, Bromley Hall has elected to adopt the following no alcohol, tobacco and illegal substance abuse policies to promote a healthy and safe living environment for its residents.

Bromley Hall has implemented its smoke-free policy to protect our community from the harmful effects of secondhand smoke. Bromley Hall joined the University of Illinois in an effort to promote a healthy living, learning and work environment. Like the University of Illinois the policy applies to everyone including our resident, our employee's and visitors to Bromley Hall. This includes all forms of burning tobacco, including cigarettes, cigars, pipes, hookahs, cigarillos and e-cigarettes. Violation of this Policy will NOT be tolerated and residents may be evicted from Bromley Hall for repeated offenses.

Our No Alcohol Policy states that REGARDLESS OF AGE, no alcoholic beverages of any type are permitted in Bromley Hall. Any resident and/or their guest(s) found in the presence of alcohol, whether participating in illegal consumption or not, will be referred to the University of Illinois for judicial hearings where their academic status may be jeopardized. Repeat offenses will NOT be tolerated and residents will be evicted from Bromley Hall for repeated offenses.

Our No Drug Policy states that the use or sale of ANY illegal substance or narcotics is absolutely prohibited. If any resident and/or their guest(s) are found to be in possession of any type of illegal drug, substance or narcotic (marijuana, cocaine, crack, etc.), the violation will be immediately reported to the Champaign Police Department as well as the University of Illinois for further legal and disciplinary action. Residents guilty of violating this policy will be evicted from Bromley Hall.

Our policies and procedures in Bromley Hall are consistent with the University of Illinois' policies that are primarily in place to inhibit the use and abuse of illegal drugs, alcohol or offensive smoking habits. We take the health and well being of each one of our residents very seriously. These policies are for the betterment of our living environment.
